

Life Group Questions October 13, 2024 1 Peter 2:4-8

do they help us further understand both his character and his purpose for coming into the world?
How does God the Father describe Jesus in these verses? Why are these descriptors appropriate?
2) The passage notes that those who "come to him" - Jesus (v.4) are "believers." In verse 5, how does Peter describe believers and the way that they are to be knit together?
Verse 5 also notes that every believer is given a role that was assigned to only 1 out of the 12 tribes in Israel – being priest. What role did the priest play in Old Testament life and worship?
What role is the believer priest to perform in the church and the world? (See also Romans 12:1-2)
3) Who are the non-believers in Jesus? What is the cause of their unbelief in Jesus?
4) How has this passage encouraged you in your life journey to "make more and better followers of Jesus?"
