1 Peter 2:18-23

1) Read 1 Peter 2:18-20. Peter is speaking those who were more than likely household servants – both free and slave – who have become believers in Jesus. As believer servants, how are they to act toward any type of master?

What reasons are given ***in these 3 verses*** as to why to act in this manner?

2) Working and living in a manner such as the bond servants in Roman times is rare in our country today. Where in our society do we experience this “master”/”servant” dynamic today?

How do these principles given to the Roman servants apply to us today? Are there limits or exceptions?

3) Read 1 Peter 2:21-23. Jesus is presented by Peter as the role model for dealing with the unjust behavior of others. What 4 things are noted that Jesus did NOT do when treated in this manner?

What was the one thing noted that Jesus DID do? How does this action relate to the fulfillment of his mission in coming to earth?

4) Verse 21 is basis for the 1896 book by Charles Sheldon, *In His Steps*, and the WWJD craze in the 1990s. How does Jesus’ example help you fulfill God’s calling in your life?
