- 2) Read Isaiah 6:1-7. What more do we learn about God’s glory from Isaiah’s vision? What is required for Isaiah to stand in God’s presence?

- 3) Read Isaiah 9:1-7. Based on the attributes of this person, who is the child that Isaiah prophesies will come?” How will they solve the sin problem that keeps us from standing in the presence of God in His glory?

- 4) Look back at 1 Peter 1:10-12. What did Peter say regarding the prophets of the Old Testament and the advent of Christ?

How can Peter’s words make the prophesy of Isaiah even more meaningful to us today?

- 5) Peter noted that the angels longed to look more into Jesus’ advent. What do you long for this Christmas?
