Romans 10:4: "Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes." (NIV)

Romans 10:5: "For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them." (ESV)

Romans 6:14: "For sin will have no dominion over you, since you [a believer in Jesus] are not under law but under grace." (ESV)
